NPS WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFYING ROUNDS

This show is affiliated to the NPS and the NPS affiliated classes will be run under NPS rules. Classes are open to Members and Non-Members of the NPS, but Non-Members will need to become Adult Showing Members to enter the finals at the NPS Spring Festival 2010. NPS General Rules of Showing apply. In each class the three highest placed ponies, not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify. Winnings in the 2009/2010 Novice and Pure Novice Winter Championships will not debar ponies from the NPS 2010 M & M Novice Ridden competitions.

BSPS WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFIERS

This show is affiliated to the BSPS and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS, are subject to the rules of the BSPS, including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS. In all classes affiliated to the BSPS, the BSPS Rules take precedence.

NPS/HIRSTMUND STUD M & M PURE NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP.

Open to stallions, mares or geldings 4 years old or over, registered in the main body of their respective M & M Stud Book. Ponies must be shown in a permissible snaffle bridle illustrated in the 2009 Rule Book. Pony not to have been placed first in any Ridden M & M Class prior to the commencement of the current Winter Series. Rider any age (except stallions – see our rule number 14)

Class 1 DARTMOOR, EXMOOR, SHETLAND, WELSH A & B.

Class 2 CONNEMARA, DALES, FELL, HIGHLAND, NEW FOREST, WELSH C & D.

Class 2a Championship. 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 1 – 2 to compete.

Class 3 NPS/CHECKLEYBANK NOVICE M & M LEAD REIN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP.

Open to mares or geldings 4 years old or over registered in the main body of their respective M & M Stud Book. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A or B not exceeding 122cms. Riders must have attained their 3rd but not their 9th birthday before 1st January 2010. Ponies are not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any Lead Rein class. To be shown in a suitable snaffle bridle, reins must go directly from the bit to the rider's hands. Lead rein must be attached to the noseband.

Class 4 NPS/CHECKLEYBANK NOVICE M & M FIRST RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP.

Open to mares or geldings 4 years old or over registered in the main body of their respective M & M Stud Book. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A or B not exceeding 128cms. Riders must have attained their 3rd but not their 12th birthday before 1st January 2010. Ponies are not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any First Ridden class. To be shown in any suitable bridle. Ponies must not be cantered except on their individual show.

Class 4a Championship. 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 3 – 4 to compete.

NPS/JOELING JUNIOR RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP.

Open to mares and geldings 4 years old or over. Classes may be split if required.

Class 5 PONIES NOT EXCEEDING 138CM.

Riders not to have attained their 16th birthday before 1st January 2010.

Class 6 PONIES EXCEEDING 138CM BUT NOT EXCEEDING 153CM.

Riders not to have attained their 18th birthday before 1st January 2010.

Class 6a Championship. 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 5 – 6 to compete.

NPS/FIRLE STUD M & M NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP.

Open to stallions, mares or geldings 4 years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective M & M Stud Book. Ponies to be shown in any suitable bridle. Pony not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any Open Ridden M & M Class. Rider any age (except stallions – see our rule number 14)

Class 7 DARTMOOR, EXMOOR, SHETLAND, WELSH A & B.

Class 8 CONNEMARA, DALES, FELL, HIGHLAND, NEW FOREST, WELSH C & D.

Class 8a Championship. 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 7 – 8 to compete.

Class 9 NPS/T.C. TACK & THINGS M & M LEADING REIN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP.

Open to mares or geldings 4 years old and over registered in the main body of their respective M & M Stud Book. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A or B not exceeding 122cms. Riders must have attained their 3rd but not their 9th birthday before 1st January 2010. To be led by an attendant and shown in a snaffle bridle, the leading rein to be attached to the noseband only. Reins must go directly from the bit to the rider's hands.

Class 10 NPS/KBIS M & M FIRST RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP.

Open to mares or geldings 4 years old and over registered in the main body of their respective M & M Stud Book. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A or B not exceeding 128cms. Riders must have attained their 3rd but not their 12th birthday before 1st January 2010.

Class 10a Championship. 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 9 – 10 to compete.

NPS/SNUGGY HOODS M & M OPEN RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP.

Open to stallions, mares or geldings 4 years old or over which must be registered in their respective M & M Stud Book. Rider any age (except stallions – see our rule number 14)

Class 11 DARTMOOR, EXMOOR, SHETLAND, WELSH A & B.

Class 12 CONNEMARA, DALES, FELL, HIGHLAND, NEW FOREST, WELSH C & D.

Class 12a Championship. 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 11 – 12 to compete.

Class 12b SUPREME RIDDEN M & M CHAMPIONSHIP. Champions and Reserve Champions from classes 2a, 4a, 6a, 8a, 10a and 12a to compete. Sashes to Champion and Reserve, Trophy to the Champion.

RING 2 (Indoor Arena)

Classes 13 – 21 are qualifiers for the BSPS Winter Championship Show. The 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th prize winners will qualify in the Mixed Height Novice classes. In the Open classes the 1st, 2nd & 3rd prize winners overall in each class and the three highest placed Restricted animals in each class will qualify. In the Mixed height Open classes the 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th prize winners overall and the four highest placed Restricted animals will qualify. (Riders on Restricted animals must wear an armband). Restricted animals may also be placed in the overall class and qualify for both the Open and Restricted sections. Animals must be registered before the date of the show at which they qualify for the Winter Championships and must be ridden by BSPS members, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies, providing they have a valid JMB Certificate before the date of the Championship they qualify for.

Class 13 BSPS MIXED HEIGHT NOVICE SHOW HUNTER PONY.

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over, not exceeding 153cm. Riders must be the correct age for the height of animal they ride.

Class 14 BSPS OPEN (RESTRICTED) PONY OF SHOW HUNTER TYPE.

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122 cm. Riders not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January 2010.

Class 15 BSPS OPEN (RESTRICTED) PONY OF SHOW HUNTER TYPE.

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over exceeding 122cm and not exceeding 133cm. Riders not to have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January 2010.

Class 16 BSPS OPEN (RESTRICTED) PONY OF SHOW HUNTER TYPE.

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over exceeding 133cm and not exceeding 143cm. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January 2010.

Class 17 BSPS WINTER OPEN (RESTRICTED) PONY OF SHOW HUNTER TYPE.

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over exceeding 143cm and not exceeding 153cm. Riders not to have attained their 20th birthday before 1st January 2010.

Class 18 BSPS OPEN (RESTRICTED) INTERMEDIATE OF SHOW HUNTER TYPE.

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over exceeding 148cm and not exceeding 158cm. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January 2010.

Class 18a Championship. 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 14 – 18 to compete.

Class 19 BSPS MIXED HEIGHT NOVICE SHOW PONY.

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over not exceeding 148cm. Riders must be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride.

Class 20 BSPS MIXED HEIGHT OPEN (RESTRICTED) SHOW PONY.

Mare or gelding 4 years old and over not exceeding 148cm. Riders must be the correct age for the height of the pony they ride.

Class 21 BSPS OPEN (RESTRICTED) INTERMEDIATE SHOW RIDING TYPE.

Mare or gelding 4 years old or over exceeding 146cm and not exceeding 158cm. Riders not to have attained their 25th birthday before 1st January 2010.

Class 21a Championship. 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 20 – 21 to compete.

Class 21b SUPREME RIDDEN SHOW/HUNTER PONY CHAMPIONSHIP. Champions and Reserve Champions from classes 18a and 21a to compete. Sashes to Champion and Reserve, Trophy to the Champion.

Class 22 LEADING REIN PONY OF SHOW OR HUNTER PONY TYPE. (Unaffiliated).
Mare or gelding 4 years old or over, not exceeding 122cm. Riders not to have attained their 8th birthday before 1st January 2010.

Class 23 FIRST RIDDEN PONY OF SHOW OR HUNTER PONY TYPE. (Unaffiliated).
Mare or gelding 4 years old or over, not exceeding 128cm. Riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st January 2010.

Judge: Miss J Ryde-Rogers, Hants.

Class 24 FIRST YEAR FIRST RIDDEN. (Unaffiliated)
Mare or gelding 4 years old or over, not exceeding 128cm. Riders must be competing in their first season off the Lead Rein.

Class 25 PART BRED RIDDEN. Not exceeding 138cm. (Unaffiliated)
Mare or gelding 4 years old or over. Riders any age.

Class 26 PART BRED RIDDEN. Exceeding 138cm. (Unaffiliated)
Mare or gelding 4 years old or over. Riders any age.

Class 27 POTENTIAL LEAD REIN/FIRST RIDDEN IN HAND. (Unaffiliated)
Yearling, 2 or 3 year old colt, filly or gelding, to make a potential Show Pony, Hunter Pony or Mountain & Moorland Lead Rein or First Ridden not exceeding 128cm at maturity. Will be split if entries warrant.

Class 28 LEAD REIN/FIRST RIDDEN IN HAND. (Unaffiliated)
4 years old and over. Stallion, mare or gelding Show Pony, Hunter Pony or Mountain & Moorland Lead Rein or First Ridden not exceeding 128cm at maturity. Will be split if entries warrant.

Class 29 PART BRED IN HAND. (Unaffiliated)
Yearling, 2 or 3 year old colt, filly or gelding. Any height.

Class 30 PART BRED IN HAND. (Unaffiliated)
4 years old and over. Stallion, mare or gelding. Any height.

Class 31 SHOW/SHOW HUNTER PONY. (Unaffiliated).
Yearling, 2 or 3 year old colt, filly or gelding, not to exceed 153cm at maturity.

Class 32 SHOW/SHOW HUNTER PONY 4 YEARS OLD & OVER IN HAND. (Unaffiliated).
Stallion, mare or gelding, not exceeding 153cm.

Class 33 HACK/RIDING HORSE. (Unaffiliated).
Yearling, 2 or 3 year old, colt, filly or gelding.

Class 34 HACK/RIDING HORSE. (Unaffiliated).
4 years old and over Stallion, mare or gelding.

Class 34a Championship. 1st and 2nd prize winners in classes 27 – 34 to compete.

NPS/LEYHILLS M & M IN HAND WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to M & M ponies registered in the main body of their respective stud books.

NPS /TOPSPEC DRESSAGE TRIAL.

The competition will run under NPS Dressage Rules in 2009/2010 and be judged by British Dressage Judges using British Dressage Tests 7 & 27 throughout. Each test will consist of five sections all of which will have their own Final at Addington Equestrian Centre in April 2010. The two highest placed ponies in each section will qualify for the Final. Part Bred Native ponies over stamped within the BRPSB may only compete in one section per season. Horses/ponies must be ridden at the final by the qualifying rider. Those qualifying for the final must be fully paid up Dressage or Showing members of the NPS for 2010 in order to compete at the 2010 NPS/TopSpec Final.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY.

1. Neither the NPS Area 20 Committee, Judges, Stewards, Assistants nor South of England Showground, shall in any way be held responsible or accountable for any theft, accident, injury, loss or damage (howsoever this may be caused) to any exhibit, person, animal, property, vehicles brought on to the showground, any premises used in conjunction with, arising out of or attributable to the show. It shall be a condition of entry that each entrant or spectator shall indemnify the show organisers and proprietors against any legal proceedings arising from any accident or misdemeanour. NPS Area 20 is covered by Public Liability insurance. Competitors should ensure that they hold adequate third party insurance cover in respect of any accident caused by themselves, their family, or helpers, their vehicles or animals when on the showground.
2. The Judge's decision is final. The class ends when the judge dismisses the class.
3. Stallions and colts, 2 years old and over must be suitably bitted and must be in possession of a current NPS or appropriate breed society licence unless otherwise governed by their individual Breed Society.
4. In all cases, whips/canes must not exceed 30" in length.
5. Objections to be made in writing to the show secretary, together with a deposit of £40, within one hour of the disputed event. If the objection is upheld the deposit will be forfeited.
6. Correctly secured current British Standard skull/riding hats must be worn at all times when mounted. Handlers of ponies in the In Hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear correctly secured British Standard skull/riding hats.
7. If for any reason the show has to be cancelled, only half the entry fee will be refunded. In no other case will any entry fee be refunded.
8. In all M & M classes, ridden and in hand, ponies must be shown as recommended by their breed society rules, and are restricted to the heights laid down by their appropriate breed societies.
9. All exhibitors must be in control of their animals at all times and any animal considered to be constituting a danger will be asked to leave the showground immediately.
10. No telephone entries. Entries taken on the day are cash only.
11. The show organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without giving a reason.
12. The committee reserve the right to substitute judges without warning or amalgamate classes due to insufficient entries in one class.
13. All dogs must be kept on leads.
14. Riders of stallions should be not less than 11 years of age at 1st January of the current year when riding small breeds, and not less than 14 years of age when riding large breeds.
15. Handlers of stallions and colts must have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January of the current year.
