Qualification for NPS Summer Championship Show

The highest placed pony owned by an NPS member in each class will qualify for the Final. Where this pony has already qualified the pony standing next in line which is owned by an NPS member and has not already qualified receives the qualification. Qualification may go no lower than 3rd place. Judges and/or stewards are requested to check membership cards prior to presenting the qualifying rosettes. NPS Adult/Standard members will be required to upgrade to Adult/Showing to enter the Final.

NPS Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition.

NPS Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register or Appendix, the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part-Breds are not eligible unless entered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register or Appendix. Ponies must be plaited. Qualifying rounds are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships

To be judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the Owner of the champion pony is a Member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the Rider's/Handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the Owner of the Champion pony is not a Member, or the Owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the Qualification Card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the Owner of that pony is a Member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the Qualification Card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship

Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in NPS Rule Book) can wear a white arm band in classes 11-12, 15 - 17, 22 - 23 & 36 - 40. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

Qualification for PUK Summer National Championships

1st, 2nd and 3rd placed horses/ponies in all Summer National Championships will qualify for the 2010 P(UK) Summer National Championships.

Qualification cards will not be presented in the ring.

Competitors in qualifying positions, who are not current members of P(UK) are allowed 14 days in which to become members and register their horses/ponies in order for the qualification to remain valid.

Equifest Qualifiers

The two highest placed exhibitors not already qualified in the relevant classes will qualify for the Equifest Showing Show 19 – 22 August. Qualification cards will be presented in the ring.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY.

1. Neither the NPS Area 20 Committee, Judges, Stewards, Assistants nor South of England Showground, shall in any way be held responsible or accountable for any theft, accident, injury, loss or damage (howsoever this may be caused) to any exhibit, person, animal, property, vehicles brought on to the showground, any premises used in conjunction with, arising out of or attainable to the show. It shall be a condition of entry that each entrant or spectator shall indemnify the show organisers and proprietors against any legal proceedings arising from any accident or misdemeanour. NPS Area 20 is covered by Public Liability insurance. Competitors should ensure that they hold adequate third party insurance cover in respect of any accident caused by themselves, their family, or helpers, their vehicles or animals when on the showground.
2. The Judge's decision is final. The class ends when the judge dismisses the class.
3. Stallions and colts, 2 years old and over must be suitably bitted and must be in possession of a current NPS or appropriate breed society licence unless otherwise governed by their individual Breed Society.
4. In all cases, whips/canes must not exceed 30" in length.
5. Objections to be made in writing to the show secretary, together with a deposit of £40, within one hour of the disputed event. If the objection is upheld the deposit will be forfeited.
6. Correctly secured current British Standard skull/riding hats must be worn at all times when mounted. Handlers of ponies in the In Hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear correctly secured British Standard skull/riding hats.
7. If for any reason the show has to be cancelled, only half the entry fee will be refunded. In no other case will any entry fee be refunded.
8. All foals must be at least 3 weeks old on day of show, and must accompany their dams into the ring.
9. In all M & M classes, ridden and in hand, ponies must be shown as recommended by their breed society rules, and are restricted to the heights laid down by their appropriate breed societies.
10. All exhibitors must be in control of their animals at all times and any animal considered to be constituting a danger will be asked to leave the showground immediately.
11. No telephone entries. Entries taken on the day are cash only.
12. The show organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without giving a reason.
13. The committee reserve the right to substitute judges without warning or amalgamate classes due to insufficient entries in one class.
14. Challenge cups to be signed for by the winner at the secretary's caravan.
15. All dogs must be kept on leads.
16. Riders of stallions should be not less than 11 years of age at 1st January of the current year when riding small breeds, and not less than 14 years of age when riding large breeds.
17. Handlers of stallions and colts must have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January of the current year.
