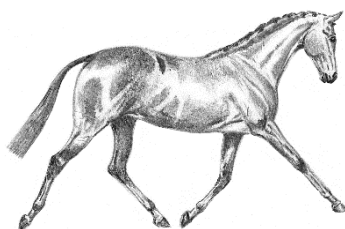

NPS Qualifying Rounds

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred's are not eligible for Mountain & Moorland Classes. To compete in Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony classes ponies must be registered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB, the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part-Breds are not eligible unless entered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS **Qualifying or Life** members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from **6th – 8th August 2019**

The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final.

Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards **MUST** be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a **Qualifying or Life** member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

Qualification Equifest

This Show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at the East of England Showground on the **29th August – 1st September 2019**. The **two** highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify

Ponies (UK) Qualification

This show is affiliated to Ponies (UK) and the 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed competitors will qualify for the Gold Medal Series at the Ponies(UK) Summer Classic 2019. No membership is required to enter or compete in any Championship Final.

Stallion Discs- All In Hand Stallions **are advised** to wear a bridle disc when showing in NPS classes. As with ridden stallions, for which it remains compulsory, these may be from any UK society providing they are easily identified or an NPS Stallion Disc may be purchased from the NPS Office.

If the Supreme and/or Reserve Supreme have already qualified then the qualification may go to the third place, but no lower.

Show Ponies not exceeding 133 cms, Show Hunter Ponies not exceeding 133cms, Show Ponies exceeding 133cms and not exceeding 148cms, Show Hunter Ponies exceeding 133cms and not exceeding 153cms & Intermediate Show Riding Type or Show Hunter Type, exceeding 148cm and not exceeding 158cm. If classes are amalgamated the highest placed pony from each height group will qualify. Riders may be any age. Rider to be suitable size for pony. The 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed competitors in class 89 will qualify for the Ponies(UK) Intermediate Show Hunter Type Gold Medal Series at the Summer Classic 2019.

Class 90 BSPA/EQUIFEST IN HAND PIEBALD/SKEWBALD. Any age or sex. The first three will also qualify for the BSPA Championships. Subject to their show rules and conditions.

The 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed competitors in class 90 will qualify for the Ponies(UK) In Hand Piebald/Skewbald Horse/Pony Gold Medal Series at the Summer Classic 2019.

Class 91 BSPA/EQUIFEST RIDDEN PIEBALD/SKEWBALD. Stallion, mare or gelding 4 years old or over. Riders any age. The first three will also qualify for the BSPA Championships. Subject to their show rules and conditions.

The 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed competitors in class 91 will qualify for the Ponies(UK) Ridden Piebald/Skewbald Horse/Pony Gold Medal Series at the Summer Classic 2019.

Neither the NPS Area 20 Committee, Judges, Stewards, Assistants nor South of England Showground, shall in any way be held responsible or accountable for any theft, accident, injury, loss or damage (howsoever this may be caused) to any exhibit, person, animal, property, vehicles brought on to the showground, any premises used in conjunction with, arising out of or attainable to the show. It shall be a condition of entry that each entrant or spectator shall indemnify the show organisers and proprietors against any legal proceedings arising from any accident or misdemeanour. NPS Area 20 is covered by Public Liability insurance. Competitors should ensure that they hold adequate third party insurance cover in respect of any accident caused by themselves, their family, or helpers, their vehicles or animals when on the showground.
2. The Judge's decision is final. The class ends when the judge dismisses the class.
3. Stallions and colts, 2 years old and over must be suitably bitted and must be in possession of a current NPS or appropriate breed society licence unless otherwise governed by their individual Breed Society.
4. In all cases, whips/canes must not exceed 30" in length.
5. Objections to be made in writing to the show secretary, together with a deposit of £40, within one hour of the disputed event. If the objection is upheld the deposit will be forfeited.
6. Handlers of ponies in the In Hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear correctly secured British Standard skull/riding hats (as below).
7. If for any reason the show has to be cancelled, only half the entry fee will be refunded. In no other case will any entry fee be refunded.
8. All foals must be at least 4 weeks old on day of show, and must accompany their dams into the ring.
9. In all M & M classes, ridden and in hand, ponies must be shown as recommended by their breed society rules, and are restricted to the heights laid down by their appropriate breed societies.
10. All exhibitors must be in control of their animals at all times and any animal considered to be constituting a danger will be asked to leave the showground immediately.
11. No telephone entries. Entries taken on the day are cash only.
12. The show organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without giving a reason.
13. The committee reserve the right to substitute judges without warning or amalgamate classes due to insufficient entries in one class.
14. Challenge cups to be signed for by the winner at the secretary's caravan.
15. All dogs must be kept on leads.
16. Riders of stallions should be not less than 12 years of age at 1st January of the current year when riding small breeds, and not less than 14 years of age when riding large breeds.
17. Handlers of stallions and colts must have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January of the current year.
18. Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet **one of the following** current Safety Standards **MUST** be worn by all Riders. All PAS 015; VG1; ASTM F1163 04a onwards; SNELL E2001; AS/NZS 3838 2003 onwards.
