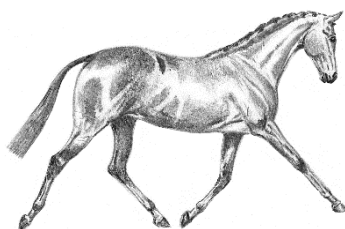

### **NPS Qualifying Rounds**

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible for Mountain & Moorland Classes. To compete in Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony classes ponies must be registered in any of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register; the GSB; the AHSB; the AASB, or registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book. Part bred are not eligible unless over stamped into one of the British Riding Pony studbook sections, or the Ridden Register.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS **Qualifying or Life** members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from **1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2023**

**The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.**

NPS/Corscaron Horse Essential Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards **MUST** be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

**NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships:** These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a **Qualifying or Life** member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

**Stallion Discs-** All In Hand Stallions **are advised** to wear a bridle disc when showing in NPS classes. As with ridden stallions, for which it remains compulsory, these may be from any UK society providing they are easily identified or an NPS Stallion Disc may be purchased from the NPS Office.

### **WALSTEAD STUD - NPS AREA 20 - SUPREME RIDDEN AND IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIPS**

TO QUALIFY FOR THESE CHAMPIONSHIPS, OWNERS OF HORSES/PONIES MUST RESIDE WITHIN KENT, SURREY OR SUSSEX AND WEAR A RED ARM BAND IN THEIR CLASSES. THE HIGHEST PLACED WITH A RED ARMBAND WILL BE GIVEN A TICKET TO COMPETE IN THE SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIPS.

### **YOUNG HANDLER OVERALL CHAMPIONSHIP**

THE HIGHEST PLACED JUNIOR IN EACH OF THE IN HAND CLASSES WILL HAVE BEEN PRESENTED WITH A JUNIOR ROSETTE IN THEIR CLASS AND WILL QUALIFY FOR THIS CHAMPIONSHIP. PLEASE WEAR YOUR QUALIFYING ROSETTE IN THE OVERALL CHAMPIONSHIP

### NPS/PICTON STUD M & M NOVICE RIDDEN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP.

To be run under National Pony Society Rules 2023. Open to pure bred registered M&M stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over.

A pony is not eligible to compete if, before 1st January in the current year, it has done any of the following:

- i. Won an open affiliated mixed M&M Ridden class
- ii. Qualified for Horse of the Year Show, Olympia or RIHS Open M&M Ridden classes
- iii. Qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate Ridden final at the NPS Summer Championship show (N.B. Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year).
- iv. If a pony qualifies for Horse of the Year Show, Olympia or RIHS in its second year it is immediately de-noviced and cannot compete in the Picton Final.

Ponies must be shown in a snaffle bit.

**Class 19 NPS/BRYNDEFAID STUD M & M NOVICE FIRST RIDDEN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP.**

To be run under National Pony Society Rules 2023. Open to mares and geldings four years old or over not exceeding 128 cm registered in the main body of their respective Breed Society stud book. Riders must have reached their 3<sup>rd</sup> but must not have reached their 12th birthday before the 1st January in the current year. The pony never to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any Mountain & Moorland First Ridden classes or qualified for the NPS/Showing Classics M&M First Ridden final before 1st January in the current year.

The winning pony from each of the NPS affiliated in hand classes held at the show is eligible to go forward to this championship. There are no specific registration criteria for ponies. The owner need not be an NPS member for the pony/horse to enter this competition or to qualify for the final but will have to become a Qualifying member to enter the final. The Supreme Champion and Reserve Supreme Champion ponies at each NPS Area show qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship show. If the Supreme and/or Reserve Supreme have already qualified then the qualification may go to the third place, but no lower.

**Class 30e WALSTEAD STUD - NPS AREA 20 - SUPREME IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP**

**THE PRICE FAMILY SUPREME IN-HAND HORSE OR PONY OF THE YEAR SEMI FINAL**

The following class is a qualifier for the Price Family Supreme In-Hand qualifier at National Pony Society Great British In Hand Show, 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2023, which is a qualifier for Horse of the Year Show, NEC, 4<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> October 2023. The objective of the competition is to find the supreme light horse or pony in-hand champion of the year, irrespective of breed or type (excluding heavy horses). The Champion horse or pony from the following classes will be eligible to compete in the Supreme In-Hand Semi Final, provided it has not already won a Supreme In-Hand qualifier in 2023.

**Home Produced M & M, Part Bred M & M, Mixed M & M, Welsh, Dartmoor/Exmoor, Fell/Dales/Highland, Connemara/New Forest, Shetland, Show Pony, Hack/Riding Horse, Hunter Pony, Anglo/Part Bred Arab, Home Produced Show Pony/SHP**

If the Champion has already qualified for Horse of the Year Show 2023 or is ineligible, then the Reserve Champion may come forward to the NPS Great British In Hand Show, provided it has not already qualified and is eligible. If both Champion and Reserve Champion have already qualified for Horse of the Year Show 2023 or are ineligible then the Semi-Final will not be represented at NPS Great British In Hand Show. Foal champions and geldings four years old and over are not eligible to compete or eligible to qualify for Horse of the Year Show. 2. The Judge's decision is final. The class ends when the judge dismisses the class.
3. Stallions and colts, 2 years old and over must be suitably bitted and must be in possession of a current NPS or appropriate breed society licence unless otherwise governed by their individual Breed Society.
4. In all cases, whips/canes must not exceed 30" in length.
5. Objections to be made in writing to the show secretary, together with a deposit of £50, within one hour of the disputed event. If the objection is NOT upheld the deposit will be forfeited.
6. Handlers of ponies in the In Hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear correctly secured British Standard skull/riding hats (as below).
7. If for any reason the show has to be cancelled, only half the entry fee will be refunded. In no other case will any entry fee be refunded.
8. All foals must be at least 4 weeks old on day of show, and must accompany their dams into the ring.
9. In all M & M classes, ridden and in hand, ponies must be shown as recommended by their breed society rules, and are restricted to the heights laid down by their appropriate breed societies.
10. All exhibitors must be in control of their animals at all times and any animal considered to be constituting a danger will be asked to leave the showground immediately.
11. No telephone entries.
12. The show organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without giving a reason.
13. The committee reserve the right to substitute judges without warning or amalgamate classes due to insufficient entries in one class.
14. Challenge cups to be signed for by the winner at the secretary's caravan.
15. All dogs must be kept on leads.
16. Riders of stallions should be not less than 12 years of age at 1<sup>st</sup> January of the current year when riding small breeds, and not less than 14 years of age when riding large breeds.
17. Handlers of stallions and colts must have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday by 1<sup>st</sup> January of the current year.
18. Correctly secured Skull Caps/Riding Hats that meet current Safety Standards MUST be worn by all Riders and must conform with current rules as shown on the main NPS website.
